Dear Parents/Guardians of SJVHS Class of 2030 Students,

The Saint John Vianney staff is committed to student success. Students who are enrolling at Saint John Vianney High School with previously identified learning challenges will be evaluated to determine the services that we are able to provide for them and they will be evaluated yearly for service renewals. While an Individual Educational Plan (IEP) or a 504 Plan are documents developed by the public school, they are not legal documents when enrolling in a private Catholic school. Saint John Vianney High School cannot provide services such as, but not limited to, individual testing, small group testing (except for final assessments), reading of tests, test corrections, use of sensory tools, Resource Room services, and more. Please note that all students enrolled in SJVHS are required to take two levels of a World Language to graduate from SJVHS.

Monmouth Ocean Educational Services (MOESC), who we partner with to assist our students who need services, will evaluate your child, and determine his or her needs for an Individualized Service Plan (ISP). The ISP, if developed by MOESC, will outline any modifications that can be made by Saint John Vianney High School to help students succeed academically.

The services that Saint John Vianney High School can provide a student who has an ISP are as follows:

- Preferential seating
- Provide copy of class notes and study guides
- Review, restate, repeat directions
- Use of aids (calculator, computer)
- Extended time to complete classroom tests/quizzes
- Break assignments into segments of shorter tasks
- Cue student's attention
- Modify test format/projects
- Peer tutoring
- Simplify verbal/written directions
- Adaptive release of assignments, tests, or notes via Canvas Learning Management System
- Provide access audio and video replay of daily lessons

Using our advanced technology, students can enlarge text using the tablet, use screen reader, use voice dictation, and adjust display to high contrast.
