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Letter from the President/Principal

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope that you and your loved ones enjoyed the summer months and found time to reconnect with your family and friends. As we prepare for the 2019-2020 school year, we look forward to renewing our commitment to Catholic education, and eagerly await the new challenges and opportunities our community will encounter during the upcoming year. As always, SJVHS strives for academic excellence! We are proud to start our new relationship with Georgian Court Universities' business department. This year, students are enrolled in several Dual Enrollment (DE) Georgian Court business classes, and the classes are taught at SJVHS as part of the student's normal schedule. Each year, additional business classes will be offered so a student can accumulate 15 or more college credits from Georgian Court University. The school continues to have success with the Early College Academy (ECA). Last years' graduating seniors in this program have successfully been accepted to Princeton University, Carnegie Mellon, George Washington University, Villanova and more. Close to a dozen of the 2019 graduates will be attending Rutgers University where all 60 of their credits have been accepted, saving a year or more of undergraduate tuition and housing costs. The class of 2023 has over 30 students participating in this program.

We are also proud to be entering the third year of the SJVHS Advanced Placement (AP) Academy. This program is designed for students to maximize the number of AP courses taken during their high school career. In the fall, 15 incoming freshman have enrolled in the AP Academy, and three SJVHS AP teachers attended week long College Board workshops this summer to learn more about new strategies for teaching AP courses. Ms. Finlay attended an AP Government and Politics workshop. Mrs. Smith attended AP Statistics workshop, and Ms. Bevilacqua attended an AP Calculus workshop. These teachers are looking forward to sharing new teaching strategies with the faculty and their students. As the leadership team continues to offer all our students the most rigorous challenges, SJVHS has expanded its in-class support personnel to compliment the current guidance office, which includes extended hours for our in-house social worker and the addition of a second Academic Support Advisor. Our staff looks forward to continuing to improve the use of technology in the classroom, with the use of online testing capabilities. The school will be transitioning to a new online learning system; Blackboard will be replaced with the Canvas system software. Canvas is utilized by a wide variety of colleges and universities. We will continue to enhance opportunities for increased project-based learning and alternative teaching techniques in and out of the classroom.

The maintenance staff has been hard at work to make our campus safe, clean, and beautiful. Several classrooms have been furnished with new cooperative group desks, and the student hallway lockers have been painted and all the locks and mechanical parts have been replaced. The downstairs classroom hallways and doors have been painted, along with the Student Dining Room. The Security Committee's suggestions from 2018-2019 were realized, with additional cameras throughout the campus; lockdown-capable doors in the Vianney Activity Center and several other areas; and a protective film on specified windows to assist in protecting our community. The outside lights in the circle, parking lot and on the building have been replaced and additional units added, with LED technology and a timing system. New lockers have been donated by Toyota World of Lakewood and Nissan World of Red Bank. The lockers have been installed in portions of both the boys' and girls' athletic locker rooms.

We would like to welcome into the SJVHS community our new students in the freshman Class of 2024, our 18 transfer students, and our new faculty members. It is with regret that Mr. Deroba, Sister Bernadette, and Mrs. Burns retired at the end of the school year. We will miss the numerous talents they brought each day to our community and wish them the best of luck in their retirements. As always, our parents, past and present, are our best ambassadors for future students. Please help us spread the word... our **Open Houses are scheduled for Saturday, October 19 and the evening of Thursday, October 24.** Finally, I am asking for your full support and prayers for the upcoming school year. We pledge to create a safe, loving environment that encourages your child to believe in his/her true capabilities, and work toward his/her maximum potential.


