At Saint John Vianney High School, we believe in the limitless potential of every student. Our commitment to academic excellence and the holistic development of our students sets us apart. We understand that choosing the right high school is a significant decision for both parents and students, and we're truly honored that you're considering Saint John Vianney for this transformative journey.

If your student has an IEP

For students with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) from their public school, we will work with MOESC to convert the IEP into an Individualized Service Plan (ISP) at the beginning of their Freshman year or the first year they transfer to SJV.

If your student has a 504 Plan

For students with a 504 plan, the MOESC team will conduct a Child Study Team Evaluation at the beginning of their freshman year or transfer year. The goal is to understand your child's specific requirements and determine the best path forward. Transitioning from a 504 plan to an Individualized Service Plan (ISP) will be guided by the findings of this evaluation. Not all students with 504 plans will be eligible for an ISP.

If your student has an ISP

For students who currently have an ISP from a private or Catholic School. If your school utilized MOESC as their student services provider, your ISP should roll directly over to SJV. All other private or Catholic schools will need to go through the MOESC evaluation process.

Student Support
