To make sure that everyone in our community stays healthy, we are changing the way we are handing Tech assistance. To avoid face to face interactions, we have set up a drop off system. You may only drop off your tablet on a Tuesday or Thursday between 9 and 11 with an appointment. **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR TABLET AT ANY OTHER TIME.** SJVHS is not responsible for your tablet if you leave it at school before or after these hours.

If you have a problem with your tablet:

1. Email Mr. Scoles at scoles@sjvhs.com. He could possibly help you fix the problem over email. You can also send him a video showing him the problem. If he can see it, he might be able to fix it without you having to drop it off.

There will be a bin under the tent at door #18 (main parking lot). **Leave your tablet in the bin with the following information: your name, your network password, your cell #, a brief description of the problem, and your SJV email. If you do not include this information he will not be able to fix it. Please attach a paper to the screen of your computer with this information.** Mr. Scoles will contact you as soon as he fixes your computer. If a pat is needed, it could take some time.

Please remember that you can use other devices at home (phone, desktop, another tablet) if you have your network password. You can access everything on the SJV website with your password.
