Founded in 1969, Saint John Vianney High School is a co-ed Catholic High School operated by the Diocese of Trenton. Located in Holmdel, New Jersey, the school resides forty-five miles south of New York City, in Monmouth County.

SJV enrolls approximately 800 students in grades 9-12. **The Class of 2022 has 223 students.**

### ACADEMIC OVERVIEW

All students must accumulate a minimum of 150 credits to graduate. The instructional curriculum is designed to provide strong college preparation with Honors, Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, and elective enrichment courses available in all disciplines. SJV is on block scheduling offering 78-minute periods. The 4x4 class schedule enrolls students in 4 classes, which meet every day for 90 days, except for Advanced Placement courses which are taught for the full year.

#### COVID-19 STATEMENT

*Beginning March 13, 2020 students received virtual instruction through the end of the school year.*

*Students received letter grades and were held accountable to the same grading standards.*

*SJV canceled all SAT testing administrations for Spring 2020 & Fall 2020.*

*For the 2020-21 school year, students returned to school on a split A/B schedule with in-person and virtual instruction rotating every other day.*

*For the 2021-22 school year, students have returned to a normal school day schedule.*

In the Fall of 2017, Saint John Vianney High School introduced a new academic program, the SJV Advanced Placement Academy. The SJV AP Academy provides students the opportunity to receive the maximum amount of college credits they can while in high school by taking Advanced Placement and dual enrollment courses during their four years. SJVHS currently offers fourteen College Board approved Advanced Placement courses and numerous dual enrollment courses.

Students enrolled in the AP Academy can choose a Liberal Arts or Science/Math track.

### EARLY COLLEGE ACADEMY

---

SJVHS's Early College Academy provides the opportunity for select students to earn an Associate of Arts degree in Social Sciences or an Associates of Science in Computer Science from Brookdale Community College at the same time they earn a high school diploma from Saint John Vianney High School. Thus, they can present two final transcripts to their accepting four-year colleges. *SJVHS is distinguished as a satellite campus of Brookdale Community College.*

ECA students spend the first 3 years on our Saint John Vianney High School/Brookdale Community College satellite campus. Students complete senior year on the Brookdale Community College campuses. (Lincroft/Freehold/Hazlet/Wall)
